Objectives and investment policy

The fund is passively managed. INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE: The aim is for your investment to track the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI Emerging Markets ex China Index (index). DESCRIPTION OF INDEX: The index is based on the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Parent Index), and is designed to reflect the performance of the shares of large and medium capitalisation companies in global emerging markets, excluding China. The index is a free float-adjusted market capitalisation weighted index. INDEX REBALANCING, CALCULATION AND ADMINISTRATION: The index is administered by MSCI Limited. The index is calculated on a total return net basis, which means that all dividends and distributions by the companies are reinvested in the shares after tax. The index is reviewed and rebalanced on a quarterly basis. The index is calculated in GBP on a daily basis and may also be rebalanced at other times in order to reflect corporate activity such as mergers and acquisitions. INVESTMENT POLICY: To achieve the aim, the fund will attempt to replicate the index, before fees and expenses, by buying all or a substantial number of the securities in



To the extent the fund undertakes securities lending to generate revenue, the fund will ultimately be allocated 82% of the associated revenue, the securities lending agent, which will be a Deutsche Bank entity, will be allocated 9% and the remaining 9% will be allocated to the DWS entity which monitors such activities, as set out in the sales prospectus and/or supplement, for its own coordination and oversight tasks. As securities lending revenue sharing does not increase the costs of running the fund, this has been excluded from the composition of costs.
