- the Sub-Fund has changed its name to db x-trackers II GERMANY GOVERNMENT BOND UCITS ETF (DR).

Further information regarding the changes above mentioned, including more detailed information regarding the Direct Investment Policy and the new Investment Manager and Sub-Portfolio Manager, are contained in the prospectus of the Company (the "**Prospectus**").
