Dear Shareholder,

We are writing to inform you as a Shareholder of the Fund that the directors of the Company (the “**Directors**”) have resolved to convene an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Shareholders of the Fund on 23 October 2026 at 10 a.m. (Dublin time) at 25 North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, D01 H104, Ireland (the “**Meeting**” or the “**EGM**”). Defined terms used which are not otherwise defined herein shall have the same meaning as in the Company’s prospectus, as supplemented from time to time (the “**Prospectus**”) and the supplement in respect of the Fund (the “**Supplement**”).

The Purpose of the Meeting

The purpose of the Meeting is to enable Shareholders to consider a proposed change to the investment objective of the Fund and certain other changes as detailed below.

Change of Investment Objective

The current investment objective of the Fund is to track the performance before fees and expenses of an index, which is the MSCI Emerging Markets Select Sustainability Screened CTB Index (the “**Current Reference Index**”). The Current Reference Index is based on the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (the “**Current Parent Index**”), which includes listed large and medium capitalisation companies in global emerging markets. Constituents of the Current Parent Index that meet certain environmental, social and governance standards (“**ESG**”) and the minimum standards for EU Climate Transition Benchmarks (“**EU CTBs**”) as set out in the Commission Delegated Resolution (EU) 2020/1818 supplementing Regulation EU 2016/1011 of the European Parliament and European Council with regards to the minimum standards for EU CTBs and EU Paris aligned Benchmarks (CTB Regulation) are eligible for inclusion in the Current Reference Index. The Current Reference Index is administered by MSCI Limited (the “**Index Administrator**”).

It is proposed that the investment objective of the Fund will be changed and that the new investment objective of the Fund will be to seek to achieve mid to long-term capital appreciation in excess of a benchmark representing the shares of large and medium-capitalisation companies in emerging market countries through investments in equities.

Updated Investment Policy

If the ordinary resolution is approved by the Shareholders of the Fund, the investment policy of the Fund will be amended to reflect that the Fund will adopt a Direct Investment Policy, following an active

approach against the MSCI Emerging Markets 10/40 Index as a performance benchmark (the **“Performance Benchmark”**). Unlike the Current Reference Index, the Performance Benchmark will not be tracked or replicated by the Fund but will instead be used solely for performance comparison purposes.

The Fund will adopt a “low Active Share” approach, meaning that the composition of the portfolio of the Fund may not substantially differ from the composition of the Performance Benchmark. The Fund will not seek to track or replicate the Performance Benchmark, rather the Fund’s investments will be actively selected and managed with the objective of delivering an investment performance which exceeds that of the Performance Benchmark. The Fund will invest primarily in equities of large and medium-capitalisation companies listed in emerging market countries. The Fund may also invest from time to time in other equities, equity related securities (such as depositary receipts like American depositary receipts and global depositary receipts), money market instruments (such as secured and/or unsecured deposits) or collective investment schemes for purposes including, but not limited to, investing temporary cash balances and efficient portfolio management in accordance with the investment restrictions. DWS Investment GmbH will be the Investment Manager for the Fund. DWS Investments UK Limited will act as Sub-Portfolio Manager, and DWS International GmbH will provide investment advice in respect of the Fund’s equity portfolio (**“Discretionary Investment Advisor”**).

Description of the New Performance Benchmark

The MSCI Emerging Markets 10/40 Index is a market capitalisation-weighted index designated to provide a broad measure of the equity-market performance in various emerging market countries. The Performance Benchmark is maintained by MSCI Limited and incorporates issuer concentration limits to remain within a cap of 10% on the largest issuer and 40% for the combined weight of all issuers exceeding 5% weight. The Performance Benchmark is reviewed and rebalanced on a quarterly basis and may also be rebalanced on an “as needed” basis. This means that the Performance Benchmark is rebalanced at the end of any day on which constituent concentration limits are exceeded.

New Investment Strategy

The Discretionary Investment Advisor will provide investment advice for the composition of the portfolio (the **“Proposed Allocation”**), using a dynamic bottom-up stock selection strategy with the primary aim of generating capital appreciation and considering multiple quantitative categories of fundamental and price-driven stock characteristics to determine a scoring model for each of the securities in the Investment Universe, such as valuation, financial strength, technical indicators, analyst sentiment, and earnings growth. The Proposed Allocation will be provided by the Discretionary Investment Advisor to the Sub-Portfolio Manager on a scheduled monthly basis. The Sub-Portfolio Manager will, in its absolute discretion, assess the Proposed Allocation and exclude and/or reweight any securities which do not comply with certain liquidity criteria, tradability of securities and portfolio diversification and the following ESG criteria.

New ESG Standards

The Fund's Investment Universe will be screened against the Investment Manager's ESG database, utilising data from Urgewald and MSCI ESG Research LLC. Companies that do not meet the applicable ESG standards will be excluded from the Fund's portfolio. Exclusions will include, among others, companies assigned an MSCI ESG Rating of ‘CCC’, companies that fail to comply with the United

Nations Global Compact principles or have a MSCI Controversies Score of 0, companies involved in controversial weapons, and companies breaching revenue thresholds in certain controversial activities including civilian firearms, tobacco production, thermal coal mining and power and unconventional oil and gas extraction (oil sands). Companies involved in coal power or coal mining expansion projects will also be excluded.

Change to the Fund's name

If the ordinary resolution is approved by the Shareholders of the Fund, the name of the Fund will be changed to **Xtrackers Emerging Markets Equity Enhanced Active UCITS ETF**.

Change to the Fund's SFDR Disclosure

The Fund currently has the reduction of carbon emissions as its objective and is subject to the disclosure requirements of a financial product under Article 9(3) of the Regulation (EU) 2019/2088 of 27 November 2019 on sustainability-related disclosures in the financial services sector, as amended ("**SFDR**").

If the ordinary resolution is approved by the Shareholders of the Fund, the Fund will promote, among other characteristics, environmental and social characteristics and will be subject to the disclosure requirements of a financial product falling within Article 8(1) of SFDR. Consequently, disclosures relating to EU Taxonomy alignment and Principal Adverse Impacts will be removed.

Change to the Fund's fees

If the ordinary resolution is approved by the Shareholders of the Fund, the Management Company Fee of the 1C class of shares of the Fund will be increased from "Up to 0.06% per annum" to "Up to 0.10% per annum" and the Platform Fee will be increased from "Up to 0.10% per annum" to "Up to 0.20% per annum". As a result, the All-in Fee of the 1C class of shares of the Fund will be increased from "Up to 0.16% per annum" to "Up to 0.30% per annum".

Change to the Fund's Anticipated Level of Tracking Error

If the ordinary resolution is approved by the Shareholders of the Fund, the anticipated level of tracking error applicable to the 1C class of shares of the Fund will be removed, reflecting the Fund's transition from an index-tracking strategy to an actively managed investment strategy.

A summary of all proposed changes is available in Appendix 1.

Shareholder Approval

Changes to the investment objective of the Fund as described above cannot be made without the approval of an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders of the Fund.

For this purpose, the Meeting is being convened and will take place at 25 North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, D01 H104, Ireland on 23 October 2026, at the times set out in the attached notice. Formal notice of the Meeting and Proxy form are attached hereto (as Appendix 2).

The quorum for the Meeting is one Shareholder present (in person or by proxy) entitled to vote upon

the business to be transacted. If a quorum is not present within half an hour of the time appointed for the Meeting, or if during the Meeting a quorum ceases to be present, the Meeting will stand adjourned until 10:00 a.m. (Dublin time) on 30 October 2026 without any further notice to Shareholders. The quorum at the adjourned meeting shall be those Shareholders present at the adjourned meeting in person or by proxy and one person entitled to be counted in a quorum present at any adjourned meeting shall be quorum. The resolution will be proposed at the adjourned meeting in the same manner as described above.

The notice sets out the text of the resolution to be proposed at the Meeting. The resolution will be proposed as an ordinary resolution, meaning more than 50% of the total number of votes cast is required for the resolution to be passed by the Meeting. If the resolution is passed by the requisite majority, it will be binding on all Shareholders of the Fund irrespective of how (or whether) they voted and the proposed changes would be expected to take effect and reflected in a revised Supplement on or around 6 November 2026 (the “**Effective Date**”).

Entitlement to attend and vote

Please note that you are only entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting (or any adjournment thereof) if you are a registered shareholder. As the sub-funds in the Company use the International Central Securities Depository (“**ICSD**”) model of settlement and Citivic Nominees Limited is the sole registered shareholder of shares in the Fund under the ICSD settlement model (the “**Registered Shareholder**”), investors in the Fund should submit their voting instructions through the relevant ICSD or the relevant participant in an ICSD (such as a local central securities depository, broker or nominee). If any investor has invested in the Fund through a broker/dealer/other intermediary, the investor should contact this entity to provide voting instructions.

The Company specifies that only those members registered in the Register of Members of the Company at 10:00 a.m. on 22 October 2026 or, if the Meeting is adjourned, at 6.00 p.m. on the day that is two days prior to the adjourned meeting (the “**Record Date**”), shall be entitled to attend, speak, ask questions and vote at the Meeting, or if relevant, any adjournment thereof and may only vote in respect of the number of shares registered in their name at that time. Changes to the Register of Members after the record date shall be disregarded in determining the right of any person to attend and/or vote at the Meeting or any adjournment thereof.

Appointment of proxies

A form of proxy is enclosed with this notice for use by the Registered Shareholder. As mentioned above, investors in the Fund who are not Registered Shareholders should submit their voting instructions through the relevant ICSD or the relevant participant in an ICSD (such as a local central securities depository, broker or nominee), instead of using the form of proxy attached hereto.

To be effective, the form of proxy duly completed and executed, together with a copy of the power of attorney or other authority under which it is executed must be deposited by Registered Shareholders, before the time appointed for the Meeting or any adjournment thereof, at the offices of the office of the Company Secretary, Goodbody Secretarial Limited, 25 North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, Ireland. Any alteration to the form of proxy must be initialled by the person who signs it.
