Objective and strategy

On November 5, 2024, the fund name changed its name from Xtrackers MSCI Emerging Markets ESG Leaders Equity ETF (EMSG) to Xtrackers MSCI Emerging Markets Climate Selection ETF (EMCS). At that time, the fund also changed its current investment objective. See the prospectus for details.

Xtrackers MSCI Emerging Markets Climate Selection ETF, seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI Global Climate 500 Emerging Markets Selection Index. Also effective November 5, 2024, the fund changed its under-lying index to the MSCI Global Climate 500 Emerging Markets Selection Index from the MSCI Emerging Markets ESG Leaders Index. The Underlying Index selects constituents of the MSCI ACWI Select Climate 500 Index (the "Parent Index") which are also constituents of MSCI Emerging Markets Index. The Parent Index is designed to track the performance of 500 stocks included in the MSCI ACWI ex Select Countries Index that meet certain environmental and climate criteria relative to their peers, as determined by the Index Provider.

Prior to November 5, 2024, Xtrackers MSCI Emerging Markets ESG Leaders Equity ETF seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI Emerging Markets ESG Leaders Index. The MSCI Emerging Markets (EM) ESG Leaders Index, is a capitalization weighted index that provides exposure to companies with high Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) performance relative to their sector peers. MSCI EM ESG Leaders Index consists of large and mid cap companies across 24 Emerging Markets (EM) countries. The Index is designed for investors seeking a broad, diversified sustainability benchmark with relatively low tracking error to the underlying equity market.

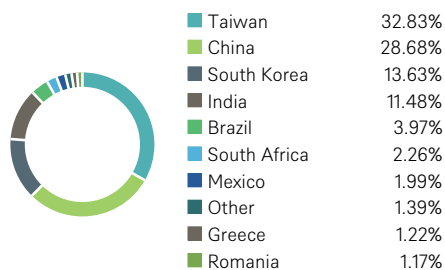

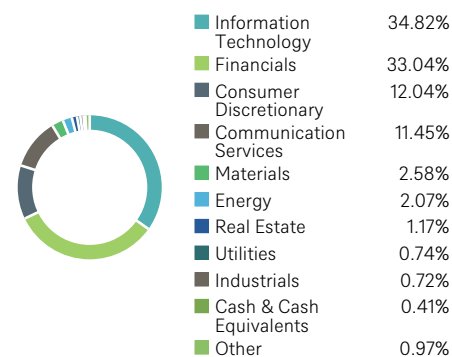

The Underlying Indices' ESG methodology, and thus the Funds' investment strategy, limits the types and number of investment opportunities available to the Funds and, as a result, the Fund may underperform other funds that do not have an ESG focus. The Underlying Index's ESG methodology may result in the Fund investing in securities or industry sectors that underperform the market as a whole or underperform other funds screened for ESG standards.
