Objective and strategy

Xtrackers USD High Yield Corporate Bond ETF seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the Solactive USD High Yield Corporates Total Market Index; a rules-based, market value weighted index engineered to mirror the performance of high-yield-rated corporate bonds issued in U.S. dollars. The Bloomberg U.S. Universal Bond Index tracks the performance of six other Bloomberg indices representing U.S.-dollar-denominated taxable bonds that are rated either investment grade or high yield.

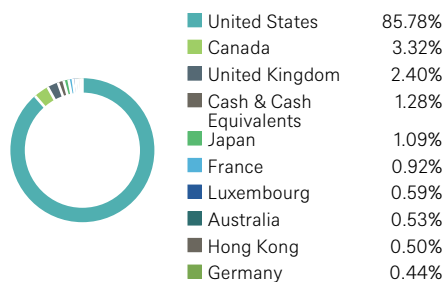

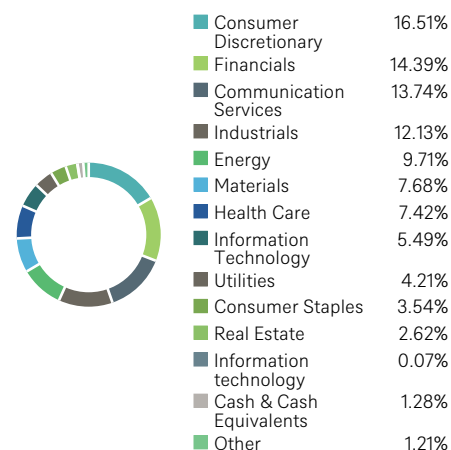

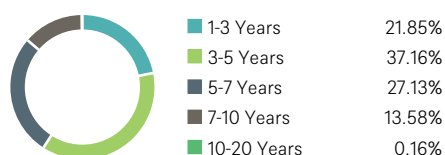

Sector weightings (3/31/26)

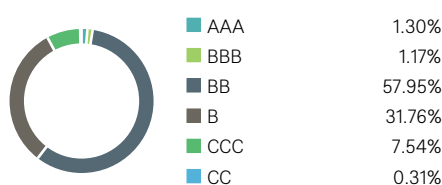


Maturity breakdown (3/31/26)

² Modified Duration to Worst is the measure of sensitivity of the price of a bond to a change in interest rates, assuming worst case scenario. Modified duration is the approximate percentage change in a bond's price for a 100 basis points change in yield, assuming that the bond's expected cash flow does not change when the yield changes.

³ Average coupon is the interest rate, expressed as an annual percentage of face value, which a bond issuer promises to pay until maturity.

⁴ Credit quality represents the highest rating of either Moody's Investors Service, Fitch Ratings or Standard & Poor's and is their opinion as to the quality of the securities they rate. Credit quality is measured on a scale that ranges from AAA (highest) to D (lowest). Credit quality does not remove market risk and is subject to change.
