Objective and strategy

Xtrackers S&P 500 ESG ETF, seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the S&P 500 ESG Index. The S&P 500 ESG Index is a broad-based, market-cap-weighted index that is designed to measure the performance of securities meeting sustainability criteria, while maintaining similar overall industry group weights as the S&P 500. The index excludes companies with disqualifying UN Global Compact scores and business involvement in tobacco, controversial weapons, and thermal coal, then targets 75% of the float market capitalization of each GICS Industry Group within the S&P 500, using an ESG score as the defining characteristic. S&P 500 Index tracks the performance of 500 leading U.S. stocks and is widely considered representative of the U.S. equity market.

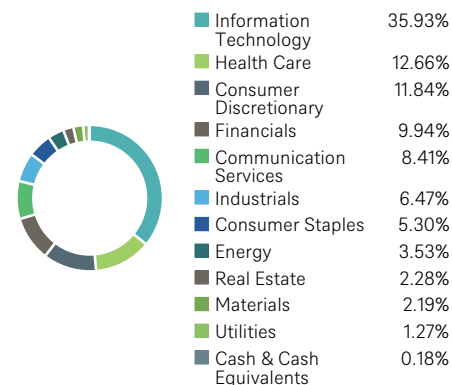

The Underlying Indices' ESG methodology, and thus the Funds' investment strategy, limits the types and number of investment opportunities available to the Funds and, as a result, the Fund may underperform other funds that do not have an ESG focus. The Underlying Index's ESG methodology may result in the Fund investing in securities or industry sectors that underperform the market as a whole or underperform other funds screened for ESG standards. In addition, the index provider may be unsuccessful in creating an index composed of companies that exhibit positive ESG characteristics.
