Objective and strategy

Xtrackers Semiconductor Select Equity ETF (the "fund") seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the Solactive Semiconductor ESG Screened Index (the "Underlying Index"). The index is a representation of securities that have business operations in the semiconductor industry and that fulfill certain sustainability criteria. Companies in the semiconductor field face intense competition which may have an adverse effect on profit margins.
